

Second Grade 2022-2023 Classroom Supply List

Student's Personal Daily Use:

The following is a list of supplies for the 2022-2023 school year. Please note: these items should be replenished by each student as needed throughout the school year.

- 2 boxes of 12 count wooden pencils with eraser tops
- 2 red pens for correcting
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 box of 24 count crayons
- 1 package of colored pencils
- 1 package of Crayola wide markers
- 1 package of Crayola thin markers
- 2 wide dry erase markers
- 2 large glue sticks (disappearing purple glue)
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 package of eraser tops
- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters labeled with your child's first and last name
- 1 soft sided pencil case to be kept in students' desks
- 1 hard plastic box labeled with child's first and last name
- 1 personal manual pencil sharpener
- 1 backpack labeled with child's first and last name on the inside
- 1 lunch box labeled with child's first and last name on the inside
- 1 reusable water bottle labeled with child's first and last name
- 1 pair of children's headphones in a container labeled with child's first and last name
